

1. Windows Tablets

- Windows tablets can be run either wirelessly (3G/ 4G) or not connected.
- If wireless, they can connect to HACCPAC on a Terminal Server/ Citrix Server using Remote Desktop Connection (RDC).
- If not wireless, you can install HACCPAC on the Windows tablet and then use **HACCPAC Laptop Sync** to synchronise between the tablet and the main HACCPAC database.
- Can use either finger or stylus (pen) – the stylus makes it easier to use dropdowns.
- Some Windows tablets include similar functionality and processing power to a laptop.
- Windows tablets run the Windows operating system.

2. iPads and Androids

- iPads and Android tablets require a 3G or 4G connection.
- Can be used to access HACCPAC wirelessly on a Terminal Server/ Citrix Server – requires the download of a Remote Desktop Connection app on the iPad/ Android tablet (free).
- Can also be used to access HACCPAC on a workstation using the following remote access apps (available for both iPad and Android - pricing based on the iPad version):
 - Splashtop Remote (free).
 - Remote Desktop Lite (free).
 - LogMeIn (\$35).
 - TeamViewer HD (free).
 - Wyse Pocketcloud (free).
 - iTeleport (\$23)
- Usually controlled using your fingers but they do have the option of a stylus which must be purchased separately.
